“An Ocean of Possibilities” is the theme Danielle Stansbury, Domestic Abuse Council Thrift Store Manager of South Daytona chose for a holiday tree decorating competition.

For the first time, the Domestic Abuse Council was accepted as one of 30 non-profits in the “holiday Magic, a festival of trees, sponsored by Florida Hospital Fish Memorial in Orange City, Florida. The charities are eligible for four prizes with the grand prize of \$3,000.00 cash.

Winners will be announced on December 15th. The 30 trees are available for purchase through an on-line bidding process. Potential buyers can participate in the on-line auction at www.biddingforgood.com/FHFM. Funds raised through the bids are designated to benefit cancer patients in the community.

The hospital provided the 6 foot pre-lit tree and non-profits were responsible for decorating the tree. The judging criteria included expression of mission, creativity and effort. Using purple as the threading color to tie together the sea shells, strings of pearls garland and ball ornaments with a ship as the tree topper. Spray painted purple shells have positive and powerful words written on them, such as safety, knowledge, prevention and education.

While the Domestic Abuse Council hopes to win, they are thrilled to be able to have this type of public exposure to raise awareness.
